After her husband died taking part in a witchcraft ritual, Sandhi's* world changed forever. Her life spiraled deeper and deeper into darkness and ruin. The financial burden quickly overwhelmed her family and forced them to move from their home near the city to a small, remote village.

By God's grace, it was in that village Sandhi met Pastor Paul, a church planter.

He showed Sandhi and her family the JESUS film in Telugu, their heart language. Pastor Paul used the film to explain the good news to them, and Sandhi and her family accepted Christ. They grew in the Lord under Pastor Paul's guidance and eventually were baptized. Sandhi took a new name, Samathana, which means "peace."

After becoming a Christian,
Samathana's peers from her social
caste no longer respected her. They
hurled insults on her way to church
and made threats against her family.
Despite the ridicule and fear tactics,
Samathana stood strong in the faith.

God has blessed her despite this persecution. Her children were able to finish school and become established adults, eventually giving her grandchildren. Most importantly, Samathana now has peace in Christ.

When talking about what God has done in her life, Samathana says her testimony is a "wow" story.

Samathana isn't the only one in her family "wowed" by the love of Jesus. Samathana's sister Vijaya, possessed by evil spirits, often acted out in fits of violence against her siblings. Sometimes Vijaya would become so violent that her brothers, at a loss for how to help, would leave her alone in a field. There she would roam all through the night, directionless and confused.

As Samathana grew in her faith, she knew Jesus had the power to help Vijaya. So Samathana began showing her sister JESUS and Magdalena: Released From Shame on DVD again and again. The first few times, Vijaya would interrupt the movies, often by screaming or falling on the floor.

But Samathana and Pastor Paul persistently prayed for her. After six months of hearing the good news of Jesus, Vijaya was released from the demonic torment. She gave glory to God and decided to follow Jesus.

Now these two sisters, changed forever by the power of Jesus Christ, freely and passionately give witness to the hope they found in Him.

A community of believers is well-established in their area now. Pastor Paul has mentored another church planter, and together these men shepherd two churches and six small groups—altogether a body of nearly 200 believers.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Jesus Film Project non-audited statement of activities does not include depreciable assets found on Campus Crusade for Christ's annual report. Jesus Film Project (the "Ministry") holds \$5.2 million of such assets consisting mainly of film-related intellectual property. An audited annual report for Campus Crusade for Christ is available upon request.

STAFF CONTRIBUTIONS

Jesus Film Project employs both supported and non-supported staff. Supported staff develop their own funds outside of central ministry funding to cover their salary and benefits. Staff Contributions reflects donations equal to their salary, benefits, and reimbursable ministry expenses for the period.

MINISTRY ACTIVITIES

Ministry Activities represent the efforts of Jesus Film Project to help build spiritual movements. The Ministry uses central ministry funds to compensate non-supported staff who fill select technical and administrative roles. Each ministry activity category includes the payroll costs of both non-supported and supported staff in which they work. The Development category (under Administration & Development) includes the portion of supported staff payroll costs used in their personal fund raising efforts. Field Ministry Strategies, the largest category, consists mainly of funds disbursed to Campus Crusade for Christ national ministries for spiritual movement building strategies. Field Ministry Operations represents expenses for ministry planning, strategy development, field relations, and reporting.

Tariq entered his friend's home, welcomed by respectful greetings and the best seat in the house. As a *Qazi* (a judge of Islamic law), he expected no less. A few dozen men had gathered to watch a film, and—now that the Qazi had arrived—it could begin.

The film began in silence. Tariq glanced around the room at his people. He wanted to guard their faith well, and he wondered what would come of this experience. Some strangers had arrived from another village, and Tariq's friend had welcomed them into his home. They had set up this film showing about the life of *Isa* |Jesus|.

Tariq wasn't sure he could trust them, but he was curious enough to watch.

About 15 minutes into the movie, someone appeared on the screen Tariq never expected to see. A figure—a man—moving through the crowd and into the water.


Tariq froze when he saw His face. He saw Jesus, and he couldn't look away. He saw His miracles. He saw His sacrifice. He saw His resurrection.

Before Shen's team left that couple's village, the team gave a smartphone to Uang and Quan, and helped them set up a social media profile and the Jesus Film® app. For weeks Shen spoke with the couple through social media. He sent them gospel messages and asked them to watch JESUS through the app in their local dialect. The couple's amazement reached new heights as they witnessed Christ speak their heart language. They quickly realized He was saying much of what Shen's team had told them.

One month after meeting Shen's team, Uang and Quan proclaimed they'd received Christ in their lives!
